In-house Awareness workshops

In continuation to awareness activities, in-house workshops were conducted at different areas of Jaipur city. The government is unable to monitor energy consumption at households level, so awareness among masses is helpful in reducing the energy consumption. With this objective, in-house workshops were organised at five locations of the city. Amar Deep Singh and Arti Pandey from CUTS participated in the workshops and interacted with participants.

Details of the activities are mentioned below:

First in-house workshop was organised by **Neh Sansthan** at Small Wonder Academy, Shankar Nagar Jaipur, on September 30, 2011. More than 50 housewives and teachers participated in the programme. Parvatan Kasana, Senior Executive, Videocon as a resource person equipped the participants with some important methods by which they can control their energy usage. He also briefed about energy efficient products available in the market. Participants also raised their queries in open discussions.
