

Road Safety Week 2004
Wef 5th Jan to 11th Jan 2004

CUTS CART actively participated in this year's Road Safety Week, which started on 5th Jan 04 and finished on 11th Jan 04.

On the first day, I attended the inaugural programme of the Govt. which was organised by the Traffic Police of Jaipur.
