

World Consumers' Rights Day 2013 Report of Street Plays organised by CUTS

On occasion of World Consumers' Rights Day, CUTS organised street plays in four directions of Jaipur city, which represent different socio-economic sections of society.



1. The first event took place at [Tonk Phatak](#), where large numbers of daily wages unskilled labourer gather in search of job. Around 175 people saw the street play. The event took place in morning.

2. The second street took place at [Gupta Store, Vaishali Nagar](#). Which attracted the attention of over 100-125 people. The event took place in afternoon.



3. The third programme took place at [Space Cinema, Bani Park, Jaipur](#), which is a centre of attraction among youths. The spot consists of mall, cinema and bus stand. The street play draws attention of over 150 youths consisting of male as well as female.



4. The fourth programme took place at old Jaipur city named as [Ramgani Chopar](#), having ancient buildings and markets. This spot is densely populated and usually in evening people gather to eat and do marketing. Over 150-200 people watched the street play organised in evening.
